STS Management Of Hypothermia-Induced Arrest

- Use Infant Warmer Mattress (drawer Of Infant Giraffe Warmer) And Place Warm Side Against Skin • Pack Axilla, Neck And Groin With Bags Of Warmed IVF (if Available) Active, Internal - Indicated For Moderate And Severe Hypothermia • Airway: If Intubated Use Warm, Humidified (40 - 46° C) Air To Warm The Tracheobronchial Tree.
